

## FlexRide Milwaukee Service Zone Descriptions

FlexRide Milwaukee includes two Milwaukee Neighborhood Zones (Zone 1 and Zone 2) and one Employment Zone in the Menomonee Falls/Butler area. Riders can travel to or from Zones 1 or 2 to access jobs or job interviews in the Employment Zone. The boundaries of these zones are described below followed by a map of the zones.

## **Boundaries for Employment Zone:**

- The Employment Zone encompasses most employment areas in the Villages of Menomonee Falls and Butler, along with small parts of the Cities of Brookfield and Milwaukee and the Villages of Germantown and Lannon that are immediately adjacent to employment clusters in Menomonee Falls and Butler.
- The northern boundary starts at a point about a half mile north of County Line Road and a half mile west of Appleton Avenue in the Village of Germantown and runs east to I-41. It then runs southeast along I-41 to County Line Road and continues east along County Line Road to Wasaukee Road.
- The eastern boundary runs south from the intersection of County Line Road and Wasaukee Road along Boundary Road until it reaches I-41. It then runs south along I-41 to a point about a quarter mile south of Silver Spring Drive. It then runs west to a point just east of 124<sup>th</sup> Street and continues south along 124<sup>th</sup> Street to Capitol Drive.
- The southern boundary runs west from 124<sup>th</sup> Street and Capitol Drive to a point just east of 133<sup>rd</sup> Street then runs north to Hampton Road. It continues west along Hampton Road to Lilly Road and runs north along Lilly Road to Silver Spring Drive. From there, it continues west to a point about 1.25 miles west of Pilgrim Road, which is just west of Kohl's Corporate offices.
- The western boundary runs north-northeast from Silver Spring Drive about 1.25 miles west of Pilgrim Road to the railroad line then runs east to Lilly Road. It continues north along Lilly Road to just south of Appleton Avenue then northwest along Appleton Avenue to Pilgrim Road. From there, it runs west to a point about a quarter mile east of Town Hall Road then south to Good Hope Road and west along Good Hope Road to a point just west of the Fox River. It then runs north essentially along the Fox River and Maple Road to just south of County Line Road, continuing northwest to a point about a half mile west of Maple Road then north to a point about a half mile north of County Line Road and a half mile west of Appleton Avenue.

## Boundaries for Milwaukee Neighborhood Zone 1:

- Zone 1 is the western Milwaukee Neighborhood Zone, located just east of the Employment Zone, and covers neighborhoods on the northwest side of the City of Milwaukee. Rides to and from Zone 1 are free.
- The northern boundary is Brown Deer Road between Boundary Road and 91<sup>st</sup> Street.
- The eastern boundary is 91<sup>st</sup> Street between Brown Deer Road and Hampton Avenue.
- The southern boundary is Hampton Avenue between 91<sup>st</sup> Street and I-41.
- The western boundary is I-41 between Hampton Avenue and Bradley Road, and Boundary Road between Bradley Road and Brown Deer Road.

## Boundaries for Milwaukee Neighborhood Zone 2:

- Zone 2 is the eastern Milwaukee Neighborhood Zone and covers several neighborhoods on the north and northwest sides of the City of Milwaukee. Rides to and from Zone 2 are \$1.50 per one-way trip.
- The northern boundary starts at the intersection of Mill Road and 91<sup>st</sup> Street, runs east to 60<sup>th</sup> Street, south along 60<sup>th</sup> Street to Silver Spring Drive, then continues east to Teutonia Avenue.
- The east boundary is Teutonia Avenue between Silver Spring Drive and Center Street.
- The southern boundary is Center Street between Teutonia Avenue and Appleton Avenue.
- The western boundary is Appleton Avenue between Center Street and 91<sup>st</sup> Street and 91<sup>st</sup> Street between Appleton Avenue and Mill Road.
