What is FlexRide Milwaukee?

FlexRide, launched in 2022, is an on-demand, workforce transportation solution connecting Milwaukee residents with suburban jobs beyond the reach of public transit. Think of us like a minibus that comes when you want, where you want – and gets you to and from work for \$3 or less each way.

What is FlexRide for Working Parents?

FlexRide for Working Parents goes a step farther to provide free rides for working parents and their kids from home to daycare, from daycare to work, and back.

What Does it Cost?

Thanks to this unique partnership between MobiliSE and Employ Milwaukee, and funding from the state of Wisconsin's Workforce Innovation Grant program, rides for working parents are <u>free</u>. And, for parents who qualify, funds may be available to help with the cost of childcare.
